Dear 11th Grade Families,

Ohio law requires all students entering 12th grade must have had two (2) meningococcal (MCV4) immunizations. These requirements are in addition to the existing school immunization requirements. The second dose must be administered after the 16th birthday. If the first dose of MCV4 was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. These requirements are in addition to the existing school immunization requirements.

In an effort to assist our families in accessing the required immunizations, we are excited to announce a new partnership between Lancaster City Schools and Healthy Schools LLC. Healthy Schools LLC will be providing MCV4 vaccines to students in the 11th grade, with parental/guardian consent, during normal school hours on Monday, May 20, 2019. In order for your child to participate in the Healthy Schools LLC immunization clinic, parent/guardian must complete and return the following form by noon on Friday, May 10, 2019:

- 2019 In-School, No-Cost MCV4 Vaccine Consent Form – attached

Insurance information is required when you register. After the MCV4 vaccine is administered to your child, Healthy Schools LLC will bill your insurance company. The co-pay is always \$0.00; therefore, you will not be charged for this vaccine. Students who participate in the immunization clinic will be provided with a letter containing their name, vaccine information, date administered, and the Healthy Schools' nurse's signature for your records. In addition, Healthy Schools LLC will update the state immunization database after the immunization clinics are completed.

ALL FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL BY NOON MAY 10, 2019.

As always, we encourage you to talk with your child's medical provider regarding all immunizations.
